Astore is a historical paradise of Pakistan. Eidgah and Gorikot are the headquarters of Astore district.

Languages: Shina is the local language while Urdu and English are also used for communication across the valley.

Famous Tourist Spots: Rama Valley is densely forested with huge pine, cedar and juniper trees. Rama Lake of the valley is one of the most stunning attractions of Gilgit Baltistan. Famous for brown bears and breath taking landscape, Deosai National Park is another famous spot. Sheosar lake at Deosai is one of the highest lakes of the region. Other prominent valleys and locations include Gorikot, Rehmanpur, Rattu, Bunji, Dashkin, Chilim, Damababho and Domail.

Popular activities: The lakes in the area are famous for fishing and angling.




